

Much of what is taught in this New Testament only era and is accepted as God's word is a perversion and an abomination to God. Time and again, chapter after chapter of the Old Testament states "And the Lord spoke". In the New Testament God's voice goes silent, leaving room for revelations and dreams of many colors.

Consider the words of God's Prophet. "Behold, I am against them that prophesy false dreams, saith the LORD, and do tell them, and cause my people to err by their lies, and by

their lightness; yet I sent them not, nor commanded them: therefore they shall not profit this people at all, saith the LORD."(Jer 23:32KJV) Those that would have you believe the words that God spoke in the Old Testament are under the law or otherwise done away with have in effect silenced God's voice and made his words of none effect. Now look at what Jesus had to say on this same subject. "And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition. For Moses said, Honor thy father and thy mother; and, whoso curseth father or mother, let him die the death: But ye say, If a man shall say to his father or mother, It is Corban, that is to say, a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me; he shall be free. And ye suffer him no more to do aught for his father or his mother; making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye. (Mark 7:9-13 K7V)

There are many euphemisms used by those who would silence God and erase his truth from the bible. They are terms like legalism, under the law, done away with, nailed to the cross, saved by grace etc. What they really mean is we don't want to hear God's

voice. Truly The Prophet Amos spoke of a time and age such as today. "Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD: and they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east, they shall run to and fro to seek the word of the LORD, and shall not find it." (Am. 8:11-12K7V) If you are a devoted Christian and want to know the answer to the question, "Is what I am doing truly God's will?" The Old Testament is the only place where you will hear God speak for God. Don't take anyone else's word! Find out what God has to say! Read study and understand the Old Testament!
